Getting back to the frigid cold, don't neglect your vehicle just because it seems to be running okay. Do necessary maintenance, it will help prevent leaving you sitting on the side of the road broken down.

It's around this time every year people start to ask themselves, "do I really need winter tires?"

It can seem like a silly question, but an important one none-theless. Because when it comes down to it, if you live in Manitoba and drive a car, it's not a matter of if you need winter tires, but how soon you should be putting them on.

Think of your car tires as a pair of shoes: there really isn't one shoe that's perfect for all the seasons in Canada. In the winter you need boots, in the summer you prefer flip flops, and in the fall a pair of running shoes are ideal. Think of your tires under the same premise. You could have all season tires on all year round, but winter tires would be better and safer. There are different tires for different seasons because it's safe for you and the other drivers on the road.

All-Season Tires

A lot of vehicle these days come fitted with all-season tires and many driver feel that they're equipped to handle "all seasons" as the name suggests. However, these tires are designed to offer benefits in both the summer and winter, meaning



there is some sacrifice in performance in order to have functionality in both seasons.

- On the other hand, an all-season tire isn't designed to handle extreme winter weather, like thick snow or ice.
- They are designed for moderate climates that don't encounter extreme cold, ice or snow. They become ineffective below +7 Celsius.
- They tend to be ideal for those who don't drive in the winter and stay in a city for their regular commute.

Winter Tires

Winter tires are designed with all winter elements in mind. From black ice to below freezing temperatures, winter tires are the only option that

covers all the bases. These tires are fitted with very specific features in place to ensure you're safe on the road when driving in the winter.

• In extremely cold temperatures,

summer or all-season tires stiffen, making them less able to provide traction.

- The tread rubber compounds of winter tires are designed to remain flexible, allowing the tire to get a better grip of the road.
- They also feature deeper tread depths and specialized tread patterns. This reduces the amount of snow buildup to improve traction and channels snow and slush to expel water and keep your tires steady.
- Winter tires also have biting edges—thousands of little slits in the tread that when on the ice, provide great traction so you don't slide around.

- 3. Whisk well before serving. Serve as a dipping sauce for potstickers, egg rolls, gyoza, or wontons.
