I don't want to sound like a broken record, but just because the winter is nice, doesn't mean it is okay to put off your vehicles' maintenance.

During this type of weather, with the short trips your engine can get a lot of condensation (moisture) build up, which can cause internal engine problems. So doing mid winter maintenance is extremely important.

Give Your Car a Checkup

Your Battery

It works harder in cold temperatures, so a weak one is a liability. It it's between three and five years old, chances are that it could fail. Check for signs of corrosion, wetness, or bulges in the casing.

Your Ignition System

Check the condition of you ignition components, including spark plugs, wires and distributor cap. Faulty components can make starting your car a game of chance, and can even cause a breakdown.

Your Tires

Tire pressure goes down in cold weather. What was okay for fall could result in low tire pressure during the winter. Check your tire pressure regularly. Remember to check your spare too.

Your Lights

Make sure all your interior and exterior lights are working. For safe driving, ensure your headlights are aimed correctly.

Your Brakes

If you've noticed any change in the feel of your brakes, or if they're squealing or grinding, it may be time to have them serviced. With black ice and unpredictable weather, having good brakes can mean the difference between stopping and sliding.



Your Windshield Wipers

Did you know that the average wiper blade lasts only six months? Check the condition of your blades if you notice streaking on the windshield. Some drivers prefer wipers designed specifically for winter driving.

Your Fluids

The fluids in your car help things run smoothly. Make sure your engine coolant meets the requirements of your area's cold temperatures. Replace the coolant if it's been more

Your Exhaust System

Check for leaks that could send deadly carbon monoxide into the vehicle.

Your Heating and Cooling System

Check the radiator hoses and drive belts for cracks and leaks. Make sure the radiator cap, water pump, and thermostat work properly. Test the strength and level of the coolant/ antifreeze, and make sure the heater and defroster work.

Pre-heat your Engine

If the temperature in your area drops below -15 C, consider using a block heater to reduce engine stress.

Keep Your Wiper Fluid Full

Keep extra fluid in your trunk. Make sure it's rated for -40C.

Prevent your Gas Line from Freezing

Keeping your tank at least half full reduces the build-up of condensation, which can freeze and stop fuel from reaching your engine.

Combat Rust

There are several ways to avoid rust: frequent car washes that include an undercarriage wash: rustproofing: and applying a layer of polymer or carnauba over paint and trim.

Strawberries and Cream Lush Dessert

Prep Time: 30 minutes Total Time: 30 minutes 16 Servings

This Strawberries and Cream Lush dessert combines a crunchy crust with a creamy center and fresh strawberries for a delicious summer treat that is sure to become a favourite!

Ingredients:

1 cup vanilla wafers, crushed 1/2 cup butter, melted 1 cup finely chopped nuts 8 oz. package cream cheese

1 cup powdered sugar

16 ounce container Cool Whip

3 cups milk

2 packages instant vanilla pudding (3.4

ounces each)

1 quart strawberries, sliced



Instructions:

- 1. For crust: Combine crushed vanilla wafers, melted butter and chopped nuts. Press mixture into a 9x13 in. pan. Bake at 350 for 15 minutes. Set aside to cool.
- 2. In separate bowl combine cream cheese, powdered sugar and 1 1/2 cup Cool Whip. Layer mixture on cooled crust.
- 3. Combine milk and vanilla pudding, mixing until pudding forms. Spread mixture onto cream cheese layer.
- 4. Layer sliced strawberries on top of pudding mixture, reserving some strawberries for top layer.
- 5. Top with remaining Cool Whip and strawberries. Refrigerate till serving.


