## Savory Breakfast Bundt Cake

**Prep. Time: 45 minutes**

**Cook Time: 40 minutes**

**Total time: 85 minutes**

### Ingredients

### 8 Servings

1 cup diced ham	2 cups low fat milk	1/4 cup green onions, chopped
2 cups baby spinach, chopped	1 cup heavy cream	1/4 tsp minced garlic
2 cups frozen shredded hash browns	12 large eggs	1/4 tsp cumin
2 cups shredded cheddar & colby jack cheese	8 cups sweet Hawaiian bread, cubed	1/4 tsp cayenne pepper



### Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 400F. Spray bundt pan with non stick baking spray.
2. In large skillet, add spinach and garlic with olive oil, saute till spinach is wilted. Remove from pan and set aside to cool.
3. Add hashbrowns and oil in skillet, fry till lightly browned, remove from heat, set aside to cool.
4. Layer in order, half the bread cubes, diced ham, green onions, spinach, hashbrowns, 1 cup shredded cheese, remaining bread cubes.
5. In bowl add eggs, milk, cream, cumin, cayenne and salt & pepper. Stir to combine, pour mixture into bundt pan, cover with foil and let sit 30 minutes, or can be made ahead of time and refrigerated overnight.
6. Top with remaining cheese, bake 40 minutes.

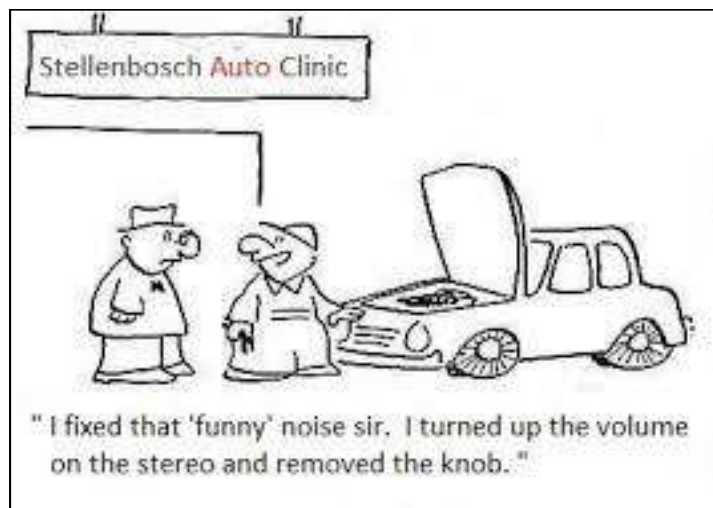
