When compared with other metals used in plug design, like copper and platinum, iridium plugs deliver a cleaner and faster burn, resulting in lower emissions, stronger starting power, and improved acceleration.

For those of you who aren't sure about making the jump from OE to aftermarket, you have to understand that such products are cost-effective and

reliable—if they come from a trusted brand.

First, quality aftermarket spark plugs will meet all the required specifications (thread size, diameter, reach, installed height, and seat type) and performance demands (heat range, starting power, and durability), so you won't have to return with ignition issues.

It's also important to remember that even though aftermarket spark plug brands develop advanced products like those with iridium electrodes, you should still make

sure they are properly tested and verified to meet the performance and reliability demands of your vehicle.

If you place priority on overall performance—including consistent ignition and better fuel economy—then iridium plugs are an ideal choice. These plugs also deliver a higher value because they are designed for longer mileage reliability than copper or platinum plugs.

No Knead Rosemary Bread

Prep Time: 1 Day, 15 min. Cook Time: 40 min. Total Time: 1 Day 55 min. 8 Servings

Ingredients:

3 Cups all-purpose flour 3 large garlic cloves, minced

1 TBSP rosemary, finely chopped, or more to taste 1 1/2 Cups water at room temperature

1 1/4 TSP kosher salt

3/4 TSP ground pepper 1/2 TSP instant yeast

2 TBSP cornmeal

Instructions:

- 1. In large bowl, combine flour, garlic, rosemary, salt, pepper and yeast.
- 2. Using a wooden spoon or your hand, add water and mix until a wet sicky dough forms, about 30 seconds.
- 3. Cover bowl tightly with plastic wrap and let stand at room temperature until surface is dotted with bubbles, about 18-24 hours.
- 4. Lightly oil a 10 inch cast iron skillet or coat with nonstick spray: sprinkle with cornmeal.
- 5. Working on a lightly floured surface, gently shape dough into a round.
- 6. Place dough into the prepared skillet. Cover with a clean dishtowel and let stand at room temperature until dough has doubled in size and does not readily spring back when poked with a finger, about 2 hours.
- 7. Preheat oven to 450F. Place in oven and bake until golden brown, about 30-40 minutes.
- 8. Serve warm.
