

Garlic Parmesan Wings (Crispy and Baked)

Prep Time: 5 minute Cook Time: 55 minutes Total Time: 60 min 24 Wings

Ingredients:

1 TBSP garlic powder

1 TSP onion powder

1 TSP salt

1 TSP pepper

1 TSP smoked paprika

2 LBS chicken wings

2 TBSP olive oil

Garlic parmesan wing sauce

1/4 cup melted butter
5 cloves garlic, minced
1/4 cup parsley, chopped

1/4 cup parmesan cheese, grated



Instructions:

- 1. Heat oven to 400F, with rack in middle of oven
- 2. In a small bowl, mix together garlic powder, onion powder, paprika, salt and pepper.
- Place chicken wings in a baking dish and sprinkle with spices, coting them well. Pour the olive oil over wings, bake for 45 minutes.
- 4. While wings are cooking, add butter to a small pot and place on low heat. Add the garlic and parsley, stir until garlic is fragrant. Remove from heat.
- 5. When wings are cooked, remove from oven. Pour the garlic sauce mixture over the wings and sprinkle with parmesan cheese. Bake for 5 more minutes until wings become crispy and brown.
